Pastor Nikolay said, "With help from outside or not, we will feed the orphans, widows, and mentally ill." Pastor Richard looks at Peter and says, **"With God's help, we can do this!"**

## THE SAMOKOV COMMUNITY

The gypsy community in Samokov has a population of over 10,000. Living conditions are extremely poor. Jobs are few. Wages are very low usually less than 100 GBP per month. Crime and disease are rampant. Many parents are in prison. There is no health care. Children and the elderly are left to survive on their own. In the midst of this community is Pastor Nikolay and the church. The little that they have is given for the care of those around them who desperately need God's love and touch.

## THE HISTORY AND PRESENT

In September 2006 Pastors Richard and Peter returned to Samokov with a Renewal ministry team. In cooperation with Mike Long of the FM Missions, progress was made on the community centre. A regional wide gypsy festival drew over 2000 persons. Again the presence of the Lord was powerful and many were saved, healed, and filled afresh with the Spirit of God. One dramatic miracle occurred in the school yard where the festival took place. Suddenly the loud gypsy music stopped, and not a sound was heard in the middle of the afternoon. Then, a young man miraculously received his hearing for the first time, and shouted praise to God!

The Lord confirmed His approval of the community centre project. Funds came in and in November 2006 the push began to finish the kitchen quickly to feed the school



children as soon as possible. In February, the church started feeding up to 50 persons everyday. In March 17, 2007, Pastors Richard and Peter returned to dedicate the centre. Even as you read this brochure, the program continues to feed the hungry. There is still a need to develop the medical examining room and classroom.
